

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Safety; Clair asked if it would be possible for the district to purchase new cabinets for the kitchen for the fire station, he was advised to get some quotes and bring it back to the board.

He also reported they are having a fund raiser to raise money for another life pack. Dann said he had not received anything from the village in response to his last correspondence in regards to the fire agreement.

Zoning; Craig submitted \$40.00 to the clerks for zoning permits. Craig reported that he went to the Prosecutor Office and signed the complaint against The House of Prayer, Ray Johnson. The trustees were given their copies of the correspondence from the EPA reference the property report.
