

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

MAY 17, 2007**

Windham Township Trustees met in regular session on May 17, 2007 with all trustees and clerk present. In attendance were; Jim Moore, Jess Wirick, George Bengtson, Clair Simpson, Craig Alderman, Tom Tauche, Don Vanderbloom, Mike Dye , Rosemary Dollison, Lori Pinti and Joe Pinti.

Minutes were read and approved.

Rosemary Dollison addressed the board in seeking some help concerning a problem with her neighbors. She said he was running a business, all sorts of vehicles and tow trucks; he also had 5 dogs he allows to run loose. She thought a fence would help correct the problem. Craig explained that we could not force them to put up a fence and he has checked the vehicles several times and they were all licensed, not much that the board could do, but he would continue to monitor the situation.

Safety: Clair reported he had to send some pagers out for repair and had ordered an additional 6 alpha pagers.

He ordered the EZIO at a cost of \$1000.00 from the donation acquired from the American Legion.

He also reported that 3 new EMT's were put on the roster Monday night; Joann Dean, Tierney Ruehr and Rachel Perrine.

Jim Moore passed out some literature that was distributed at his exploratory committee for a joint fire district last evening.

Joe Pinti questioned the board as to why none of its members were at the meeting to represent the township and what stand the board took on the district. Dann explained that the Board has opposed the creation of a joint fire district, but were willing to review what the committee came up in their fact finding.

Mr. Moore said that the next meeting of the committee would be June 6<sup>th</sup> @ 6:30pm.

Zoning; Craig reported Mr. Ensinger has 14 more days, he will then send the information to Chris to start litigation.

Dann reviewed what was going on the Horner property and he also said he had tried to contact Sicuro in regards to the ongoing Johnson case but he was out until Monday, but Dann will try to make contact again to see what the hold up is.

Lori Pinti also requested someone check on the property on Parkman Rd. across from Wolf Rd, there was a single wide trailer back there and she thinks someone may be living in it; Craig had checked on this before but will check again.
