Zoning:

In reference to the abandoned nonconforming mobile homes .Prosecutor Meduri has sent letters to Mary Wengatz in regards to the property at 8550 Gotham and Joy Rosa Lindon in regards to the property at 8542 Gotham Rd. notifying them of the zoning violations. Dann explained the process the Township has to follow and it is quite a long process, recommend they continue calling the Sheriff's Department when necessary and calling the dog warden in regards to the dog at large problem.

Mr. Garner also commented on Mr. Timmons property on St Rt. 82, thought maybe he could move his farm machinery to the back of the lot so that it not be visible from the road.
