3-1-2020

Zoning:

2. Joe Pinti reported that an Agriculture permit was issued to Dan Lucas on State Route 303. All the proper paperwork was filed for forestry.

4. There was discussion on the Liberty Street on the property up for sale. It is 21.4 acres vacant land with a 61.4 foot frontage that is currently zoned agriculture.

New Business:

Garbage clean up is scheduled for April 3-4, 2020 with a limit of 5 dumpsters. There is currently no tire clean up. We will be looking into options to take tires. The cost is high to have our own tire clean up.
